Singer Julia Kozakova is best known for her solo work and her previous album *Manuša*, released in 2022, saw her bring new life into traditional Roma songs originally from Slovakia and Central Europe. Julia's band are a group of exceptional Roma musicians from her home town of Bratislava who perform on cimbalom, violin, viola, double bass and guitar.

Since she was 13, Julia has worked closely with Roma artists and has collaborated with Czech singer Ida Kellarova and toured Europe with her Romany children's choir Čhavoreng. Her breakout and internationally released debut album *Manuša* brought Julia a new audiences performing in UK, Czech Republic and Slovakia and also received positive media feedback - it was the best performing world music album from Slovakia according to the World Music Charts Europe (WMCE) and has received Radio Head Award for the 'best Slovak world music album' of 2022. Julia studied at London's SOAS and continues to study 'jazz voice' at Janačkova Akademie in Brno (Czech Republic)
